It currently resides in the Exhibition Hall of the National Archive in Washington, D.C.
- 2) July 8, 1776 - The citizens of Philadelphia were summoned to the State House Yard by the bells of the city. At noon, Colonel John Nixon publicly read the Declaration of Independence for the first time.
- 3) 1933 - Batter up! Major League Baseball holds its first All-Star Game, played at Chicago's Comiskey Park.
- 4) 1963 - To help speed up mail delivery, the Postal Service begins implementing the ZIP code system.
